People will also have the right to access their information via a subject access request and companies must provide this within a month. If any data is inaccurate, companies must correct it.

5 key principles of data privacy that organisations must ...

There are five key principles of data privacy that organisations must follow if they are to ensure compliance: 1. Storing data appropriately. Article 5 of the GDPR states that data must be “kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed.”

The protection offered by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) travels with the data, meaning that the rules protecting personal data continue to apply regardless of where the data lands. This also applies when data is transferred to a country which is not a member of the EU (hereinafter referred to as 'third country').
