Toyota Corolla (E20)

The Corolla E20 was the second generation of cars sold by Toyota under the Corolla nameplate.. The second-generation KE2# / TE2# model, launched in May 1970, had "coke bottle styling".It had a longer 2,335 mm (91.9 in) wheelbase. The front suspension design was improved greatly, using a swaybar, however the rear remained relatively similar.

Toyota Corolla (E110)

The Corolla E110 was the eighth generation of cars sold by Toyota under the Corolla nameplate.. Introduced in May 1995, the eighth generation shared its platform (and doors, on some models) with its predecessor. Due to a recession, Toyota ordered Corolla development chief Takayasu Honda to cut costs, hence the carry-over engineering.
